It is the responsibility of the pilot performing the maneuver to ensure the rest of the field knows his intentions. During combat, ensure you wait until all planes are down, BEFORE you proceed onto the field. There are electric planes in combat now, and they don't make much noise. Don't let the lack of engine noise fool you into thinking all planes are down.
